The La Chaise lounge chair dates back to 1948, when it was developed for the 'International Competition for Low-Cost Furniture Design' organised by MoMA. The name is a playful reference to artist Gaston Lachaise, whose Floating Figure sculpture was a source of inspiration for the Eameses.

La Chaise's striking organic silhouette could easily be mistaken for an abstract sculpture rather than a piece of seating furniture. Recognised as a symbol of organic design, the softly undulating shell has a relaxed appearance and invites the viewer to take physical possession of it and explore the multiple manners in which the body can recline. Resembling a free-standing work of art, La Chaise is made up of three distinct components: the shell is mounted on five chrome-plated steel rods, which are anchored in a cruciform oak base.

La Chaise has been produced exclusively by Vitra since 1990.



Verner Panton was an influential figure in the development of design during the 1960s and '70s. After moving to Switzerland in the early 1960s, the Danish designer became known for his inventive, novel ideas for furnishings, lighting, and textiles. The masterful use of color was a hallmark of his work.

Panton's collaboration with Vitra began in the early 1960s, when they jointly developed what became his best-known design, the Panton Chair, which was introduced in 1967. This was also the first independently developed product by Vitra.

Jean Prouvé, who regarded himself as an engineer throughout his lifetime, was both the designer and manufacturer of his product ideas. His unique oeuvre, ranging from a letter opener to door and window fittings, from lighting and furniture to prefabricated houses and modular building systems, encompasses almost anything that is suited to industrial production and construction.

In close cooperation with the Prouvé family, Vitra began in 2002 to issue reeditions of designs by this great French constructeur, including the introduction of new archival colors and a number of lesser known designs in 2022.








The Wooden Dolls by Alexander
